Inhalation Move to the fresh air and call a doctor promptly.

Contact with eyes Wash immediately under running water for 15 minutes at least, remove contact lenses, rather longer. medical care promptly.

DISPOSAL OF PREPARATION AND PACKAGING (PHONE INTERFERE EMERGENCY 123456)



Remaining gas can be released into the atmosphere in a well ventilated place or outdoors. Forward the gas tank to the manufacturer for disposal.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACCIDENT OR FIRE ACCIDENTAL RELEASE (PHONE 150)



Ensure adequate ventilation. in case of fire use powder fire extinguishing media and call firefighters.
